1. Introduction

- 20 Students (from Classes VI–XII, nominated on basis of interest & enthusiasm)
- Student Leaders: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Activity Coordinators
- Community Representative
- One Parent Volunteer / Alumni / Local NGO Member (if available)

4. Proposed Activities under Mission LiFE

- a. Green School Campaign: Plantation of saplings and development of herbal garden.
- b. No Plastic Drive: Awareness against single-use plastics in and around the school campus.
- c. Energy & Water Audit: Students to monitor wastage of electricity and water.
- d. Bird & Animal Care: Installation of clay pots and water feeders during summer.
- e. Eco Celebrations: Observing World Environment Day, Earth Day, and Van Mahotsav.
- f. Skill Building Workshops: Training on compost making, recycling, paper bag making, etc.
- g. Community Outreach: Street plays, rallies, and exhibitions on Mission LiFE themes.

5. Monitoring & Evaluation

Monthly meetings of Eco Club members.

Activity reports to be submitted to Principal at the end of each term.

Photographs and documentation of all activities for record keeping and CBSE/State level submissions.
